**ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 SECTION 14 (1)**

**TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC**

**HORNSEA ROAD, SKIPSEA ROAD (PART), BEWHOLME ROAD (PART), ATWICK AND**

**ATWICK ROAD, MILL LANE AND MARKET PLACE (PART), HORNSEA**

Notice is hereby given that The East Riding of Yorkshire Council intends not less than seven days from the date of this notice to make an Order, the effect of which will be to prohibit any vehicle from proceeding along:

Skipsea Road, Atwick (**FROM** approximately 100 metres to the north of the junction of North Road **TO** the junction of Church Lane)

Bewholme Road, Atwick (**BETWEEN** the access to The Black Horse Inn **AND** the junction with Hornsea Road, Atwick)

Hornsea Road, Atwick (full extent)

Atwick Road, Hornsea (full extent)

Mill Lane, Hornsea (full extent)

Market Place, Hornsea (**BETWEEN** the junctions with Mill Lane/Eastgate **AND** Bull Ring Roundabout)

commencing **12 May 2022** to enable carriageway maintenance works to be carried out by East Riding of Yorkshire Council.

**The road closures are necessary to enable the works to be carried out in a manner consistent with ensuring the safety of the public.**

The Order is valid for 18 months but **it is estimated that the works will be completed by 27 May 2022.**

**The alternative route for traffic affected by the road closures will be via:**

Bull Ring Roundabout, Westgate and Seaton Road, Hornsea

Hornsea Road, Main Street and Leas Lane, Seaton

West Road, Siggleshorne

Main Street and Leven Road, Catwick

Leven Roundabout and Leven Bypass from Leven to Brandesburton, Leven

Brandesburton Roundabout and Bridlington Road, Brandesburton

Beverley Road and Skipsea Road, Beeford

Beeford Road, Skipsea Brough

Beeford Road, Main Street and Hornsea Road, Skipsea

Skipsea Road, Atwick.

**The alternative route for traffic affected by the Bewholme Road, Atwick road closure will be via:**

Bewholme Road, Atwick

Atwick Road, Bewholme

**THEN, IF HEADING NORTHWARDS:**

Seaton Road, North Road, Gardham Lane and Skipsea Road, Bewholme

Bewholme Lane, Skipsea Brough

to then join Beeford Road, Skipsea Brough as detailed above

**OR, IF HEADING SOUTHWARDS:**

Seaton Road, Bewholme

Bewholme Lane, Seaton

to then join Main Street, Seaton as detailed above.

The diversion routes will be signed at the time of closure. The roads will be closed to all traffic but **access will be maintained for residents, the emergency services and pedestrians.**
